

## **Action Taken Report of IQAC**

### **Meeting on 27.11.2019**

The following activities were undertaken as resolved in the IQAC meeting held on 27.11.2019.

1. The database of the students for the session 2019-20 have been prepared and verified through IQAC mail.
2. Students' feedback of +3 rd year students for the session 2019-20 have been collected and analysed.
3. As decided by the IQAC committee, a proposal of Rs. 40 lakh for constructions of college boundary, completion of auditorium hall has been submitted to Sj. Anubhav Mohanty, Hon'ble MP, Kendrapara Loksabha constituency in letter no 1616 dated 03.12.2019 through the collector, kendrapara. This was also regularly followed by Sj. Dhruva Sahoo , MLA Rajnagar and principal of this college. But nothing is yet materialised. The same request has also been made to Sj. Dharmendra Pradhan, Hon'ble Minister, Steel and Petroleum , Govt of India in letter no 1614 dated 03.12.2019.
4. A similar request has also been made repeatedly to Executive Officer, Municipality, Pattamundai to install adequate nos of separate dust bins for different wastes in the college campus in the letter no 182 dated 31.01.2020 and no action has been yet taken in this regard. A mail has also been sent to RO, State Pollution Board, Paradeep regarding disposal of E-waste on date 12.02.2020 and also he agreed to come here for the disposal of the same. But it was delayed due to present pandemic situation.
5. As per the decision of the committee, a request has also been made to Sj. Dhruva Sahoo, MLA, Rajnagar to widen and increase the height the back side road and canal bridge. He also promised verbally to do the same as far as practicable. He also sanctioned 8 lakh from his LAD for the construction of college boundary.
6. 20 nos of white board have been installed in different department seminar halls as well as and other class rooms.
7. A meeting of office bearers of alumni association with principal has also been convened regarding NAAC reaccreditation and Golden jubilee

celebration on dated 11.11.2019 in which **golden jubilee logo** was also inaugurated by Sj. Dhruva Sahoo, President GB and Hon'ble MLA, Rajnagar.

8. All the 14 departments have been completed two extramural seminars as well as a state level seminar successfully as per the decision of IQAC committee.
9. AQAR 2017-18 has been successfully submitted to NAAC and AQAR 2018-19 have already prepared and will be submitted at the end of May 2020.
10. AQAR 2019-20 will be prepared and has a plan to submit the same by the end of July 2020
11. All the regular activities of the college such as Annual Sports, Drama, Cultural, Annual Function, Science Society Function, Odia Sahitya Samaj function have already been completed in scheduled time.
12. The automation work of library has mostly completed and will be operational within short period. The process was delayed due to continuous lockdown for COVID -19
13. A blood donation camp was also organised on 28.04.2020 in collaboration with Jiban Bindu, Odisha where 30 units of blood was collected during lockdown period.
14. One day salary of the staff members amounting Rs 1,05,300/- was donated to the Odisha Chief Minister Relief fund: COVID-19 on 28.04.2020 to fight against the present pandemic situation.
15. All the financial transactions of the college are completely digitalised from this financial year 2019-20.
16. The lavatory for ladies in staff common room and post office of college were renovated and a new lavatory in the department of zoology is under construction.
