





## REPORT

## **Gender Discrimination in India**

Men and women both are equal and play a paramount role in the creation of development of their families, of the society and of the country. Indeed, the struggle for equality has been one of the major concern of the women's movement all over the world. The differences in sex and physical form denotes no differences in status. Women is the complement of men not inferior. In India, since long back women were considered as an oppressed section. The birth of the son is being celebrated as joy while a birth of a daughter is filled with pain. Boys are encouraged to be tough and outgoing but girls are encouraged to be homebound and shy. Boys are allowed for all type of enjoyment but girls are not. All these are gender difference which are created by our society and by us. This gender inequality has bad impact on our nation development and on our economic growth. It hampers the overall development because by excluding a number large portion of population from socio, economic, political activities how can we imagine overall development of the society. That's why gender inequality is different from other type of inequalities. Gender inequality is a reality in India and since long India following it. In recent time with the development of modernity a lot of women are doing well in all sphere and gaining name and fame for the country but still there are a lot of women who are facing inequality and discrimination in the society and in the family. As per the UNDP report, India ranks 132 out of 187 countries on gender inequality index (GII). In parliament only 10.9% of law makers are women, 80% women of Indian women didn't have bank account in 2016, as per the UNDP report every day 39000 girls are forced for marriage.

**Gender Discrimination in India:**

we all know that gender is a social concept which has created by our society. People set certain rules and regulation or u may call it certain characteristics are fixed for women and men` so normally gender inequality refers to unequal treatment or perception of individual based on their gender. It arises from

difference in socially constructed gender roles. This way gender is totally different from sex. Because sex is biologically determined whereas gender is socially constructed concept. Gender inequality in India is a very common problem. It is a known fact that inequality starts from even before the girl child is born and sometimes, she is killed as fetus. Which makes up the highly skewed child sex ratio where for every 1000 boys in India, there are only 908 girls.

Gender roles, responsibilities, inequality and difference are not the same in various societies. In developed states like Kerala, Punjab women have a good position rather than Uttar Pradesh and Bihar. Usually, women are treated unequal than men in their education, career, economic advancement, and in political influence. Gender inequality is a common type of inequality that is happening throughout the world even in the developed countries.

The sexual discrimination found in India are

#### 1. INEQUALITY IN EDUCATION:

Women are treated unequally in the matter of admission, recruitment, financial aid, grading housing class room, academic program, vocational education. As per the 2011 census report data effective literacy rate (age 7 and above) were 82.14% for men and 65.46% for women. the main reason behind parents unwilling to spend on girl's education is the mindset that educating women is of no value as in future they will only serve their husband and in-law's house. A large number of male students take admission in medical and engineering colleges whereas girls students take admission in arts and vocational colleges. Sexual harassment in school and colleges drastically reduced the percentage of girls' students.

#### 2. INEQUALITY IN EMPLOYEMENT:

This is a major problem woman have to face in work place. They are deprived of the basic rights at the work place and often harassed by the co-workers. Even their sometimes treat women unfairly. In many work place women are a minority. for decades women have earned more bachelor degrees, master degrees, and doctorate degrees than men yet women still earn less than their male counterpart.

An obstacle that many working women face in the work place is sexual harassment. while the # me too movement has helped

to shed light on the issue. A survey conducted in January 2018 by the nonprofit stop harassment found 38% of women have experienced sexual harassment in the work place and 8% reported experiencing some form of sexual harassment in their life time, including verbal or physical assault. An Oxfam report on inequality published in January revealed that in the work place woman's till receives 34% less wages than their male counterpart for the same work.

### 3. INEQUALITY IN POLITICS:

India has not yet a great representative of women at the center or state politics. The lack of representation at the parliament and in the state, assemblies come in the way of highlighting and addressing the grievances of women as a social group. India continues to perform poorly on the united Nation's Gender Inequality Index, ranked lower than several of her neighboring countries. These countries have begun to perform better due to several reasons, but also by ensuring reservation of seats for women ,recognizing them as a historically subjugated class of citizenship`

While India gave all its citizens the right to suffrage simultaneously, due to orthodox and patriarchal set up of the India society, women did not emerge as a strong voter. The last decade however, has a different story unfolding where the 17% gender gap recorded in the parliamentary election of 1957 has been reduced to little over 1% in 2014 election. And also about 2/3 of women report consulting family, friends or colleagues while exercise their vote. The percentage of women vote is really very low.

### 4. RACISM :

Unfortunately, race seems to play a major role in how women are treated and compensated in the work place and during marriage time. The payment, a woman receives may vary depending on her race and ethnicity. Even in the time of marriage the color of the bride is given much more important than the color of the groom. In some work place and in marriage proposal fair color considered as important.

### 5. INEQUALITY IN FAMILY:

From birth parents interact differently with children depending on their sex, and through this interaction parents can instill different values or traits in their children on the basis of what is normative for their sex. This internalization of gender norms can be seen which type of toys parents

typically give to their children. Normally soft toys and dolls are given to girl child whereas gun, masculine toys are given to boys. family is the starting point which creates gender inequality. In maximum family's boys are given maximum freedom and opportunities rather than girls.

#### 6. CHILD MARRIGE:

Child marriage in India has been practice for centuries, with children married off before their physical and mental maturity. the problems of child marriage in India remains rooted in a complex matrix of religious traditions and cultural matter. Children specially the girls are married at a very young age. This proves fatal for their overall development and have a negative impact on their health too. UNICEF said there are 40% of child marriage prevalence in Bihar, Rajasthan and Bengal., Uttar Pradesh.

#### 7. ACID ATTACKS AND RAPE:

Rape is a very common problem in India. In Every 15 minutes a girl child is rape victim in India. You can see the burning examples of Nirvaya rape case, Priyanka ready rape case, Ashifa rape case, and Uunao gang rape case. It is because women are unequal with men. According to the National crime Records Bureau more than 32500 cases of rape were registered with the police in 2017, about 90 a day.

Acid attack is considered to be a vicious crime that means throwing acid of the body parts of a person. It is a form of violent assault' India Today Data Intelligence Unit has found that between 2014 and 2018, there have been 1483 victims of acid attacks in the country. According to the NRCB Report, at 13 cases each kerala and Odisha had the 4<sup>th</sup> highest number of acid attacks reported in 2017. About 300 acid attacks are reported in India each year.


## REPORT
