REPORT

TECHNICAL SESSION II:-



REPORT OF THE RAPPORTEUR

TECHNICAL SESSION-I :-

A meeting was convened in the 1st technical session at 11A.M. just after the inaugural session under the chairmanship of Prof Bharat Chandra Patra, Former Principal SSJ Mahavidyalaya, Rajnagar, Kendrapara, with help of the Rapporteur Dr. Manoj Kumar Das, Asst. Professor in Economics, Ravenshaw University, Cuttack. Prof. B.C Patra welcomed and introduced the resource persons of this session. He also requested Dr. M.K. Das to brief down the talks of all the resource persons of this session. Then, he requested Prof. S. N. Behera to deliver his speech. Prof. S. N. Behera described elaborately the major factors responsible for current economic slowdown in India. He also explains about the current steps that have been taken by the government to overcome from such problem. He explained how low manufacturing product, low agricultural production and low performance of service sector are responsible for current economic slowdown in India.

He concluded that along with the above factors world economic crisis of 2008 is also responsible for the decline in GDP growth rate for the last six consecutive quarters.

Thank you , Sir for your valuable talk which makes our audience, specially our students, more resourceful about the basic concept of economic slowdown. Next Prof. B.C Patra requested Dr. Chitaranjan Nayak renowned Economist to deliver his talk about the topic **“Economic Slowdown in India: Factors Responsible and Policy Measures”**.

The current economic slowdown is a short run phenomenon and it is cyclical in nature. The GDP growth rate has been declined to below 5% in the second quarter of FY 2019-20 which is due to fall in aggregate demand, Dr. Nayak focus on the fiscal policy of the government which can solve the problem of economic slowdown through high government expenditure. .

Thankyou sir, for your valuable, inspiring talk about role of fiscal policy to overcome the problem of economic slowdown.

TECHNICAL SESSION-II :-

Another meeting was convened in the 2nd technical session, which was started at 2.30 P.M, under the chairmanship of Prof. Atalu Kumar Bal, Reader in Economics SSJ Mahavidyalaya, Rajnagar, Kendrapara with the help of the Rapporteur Dr. Manoj Kumar Das, Asst. Professor in Economics Ravenshaw University, Cuttack.

Prof. Bal welcomed and introduced all the resource persons of this session and he also requested Dr. Das to brief down the talk of all the resource persons of the session.

Prof. Atalu Kumar Bal invited Mr. Pitabas Biswal, Lect. in Economics to deliver his talk. The topic of Mr. Biswal was “**Indian Economy at a Crossroad**”. Decline trend of Investment, export and rising trend of unemployment forcing Gross Domestic Product of India to grow at a very slow rate over quarters although the economy has not been hit by any standard triggers of slowdown i.e. food harvest have not failed, world fuel prices have not risen and fiscal situation is under control. The Current slowdown is attributed to some cyclical and structural factors lead by crisis in banking sector and Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs). Keeping it in mind to bring the economy back to health, both Govt. of India and Reserve bank of India have been trying vigorously to bring the economy back to health, but investment mired in its slump and lending continues to decelerate. Thank you sir, for your nice talk regarding economic slowdown.

Then Prof. Atalu Kumar Bal invited Mrs. Kuntala Das, HNS College Chandol, to deliver her talk. Her topic was “**Growth of Agricultural Productivity: A Way out from Economic Slowdown in India**”. In recent time Indian economy has come across a drastic fall in its Gross Domestic Product and the performance of major sectors are very poor. The situation has so worsen that it has become more severe than 1991 and 2008 global economic crisis. It seems headed for the intensive care unit. Macroeconomists argue that it is structural which attribute the problem of structural constraints such as labour and land restrictions and governance (Rajan, 2019; Sharma, 2019). Then there are the cyclicalists, who focus on more recent developments, attributing the slowdown to a slump in aggregate demand, explained by problems in agriculture (Kotwal and Sen, 2019; Damodaran, 2019; Ghosh 2019; Dev and Goyal, 2019); demonetization and GST (Banerjee, 2019; S.Subramaniam, 2019); monetary tightness (Balakrishnan, 2019); or policy and political uncertainty (Singh 2019; Basu 2019). So the need of the hour is to increase the aggregate demand of the economy which largely depends on the income of the people. It can

be achieved if there is growth of agricultural productivity because of it provides livelihood around 50 per cent of the total population.

Thank you madam, for your valuable talk which makes the audience specially our students more resourceful about the current economic situation of India.


Then Prof. Balin invited Sri. Rajib Lochan Jena, Laxmi Barah College, Ayatpur, to deliver his talk. He explained his topic **“Economic Slowdown in India an Overview From 2010-11 to 2019-20”**.

The current slowdown in India's economic growth is now widely acknowledged. It is not a mere cyclical (or short-term) decline, as the Government would like us to believe. The economy has been underperforming for quite awhile after the boom of the 2000s went bust. Regrettably, the current GDP series, like a faulty speedometer, has been over-stating output growth. It probably helped policymakers propagate a false narrative of India as a consumption-led success story, ignoring warning signals of a decade-long decline in the economy's saving and investment rates (among other evidence). Such a reversal in the investment rate for so long has never happened since Independence. Hence, our first task was to place together the recent aggregate data to present a clear and credible account of the economy's performance. Thank you Sir, for your extraordinary talk about the topic.

Finally, as a faculty of Economics, I extend my thanks to all the Resource persons, delegates, Organisers, Staffs & students of the College, media persons as well as esteemed Principal of this College. 
