REPORT

The one-day state level seminar was successfully organized by Department of Education, Pattamundai college, Pattamundai on 24th January, 2020 at 10 A.M. in the auditorium hall under the Chairmanship of Prof. Adhikari Laxminarayan Dash, Principal-cum-President of the seminar, Pattamundai College, Pattamundai. The programme was started as according to the agenda (**Annexure-A**) with lighting of the lamp by our guests which was followed by state anthem sung by our department students. Introduction of guests was presented by Ms. Neerupama Swain, Lecturer in Education. The theme paper of the seminar was read out by Dr. Rajalaxmi Mohanty, HOD of Department of Education. Following to it was the welcome address by **Sri Adhikari Laxminarayan Dash** Principal-cum-Chairperson of the meeting.

Then the august house was addressed by our **Guest of Honor Dr. Sanjaya Ketan Swain**, Associate Professor (Retd) S.V.M College, Jagatsinghpur. He focused that the report proposes an education policy, which seeks to address the challenges of access, equity, quality, affordability and accountability faced by the current education system His addresses was followed by the address of the **chief speaker Dr. Sudarshan Mishra**, Reader and HOD, Deptt. of Education, Ravenshaw University. He pointed out that the major focus of the whole documents is to bring quality in education he further pointed out certain anomalies are found in the document which needs to be revisited. Then was the talk of our **Chief Guest Prof. G C Nanda**, Prof. and Principal, University Department of Teacher Education, Bhubaneswar. He addressed that time has come to take stock of the ground realities in Pattamundai College and prepare a vision document to work as an autonomous college and perform well as per the vision statements to be upgraded to a teaching university. A multidisciplinary environment is to be created in the college and the existing curriculum under choice-based credit system is to be further extended to prepare an imaginative, flexible curriculum plan and pedagogy at the institute level.

The rapporteur of the session was Dr. Tarulata Devi, Asso. Professor, Dept. of Education, P.P.College, Nischintakoili, Cuttack.

The valedictory session was started at 4.30 P.M. and ended at 5.30 P.M. Prof. Adhikari Laxminarayan Dash, Chairperson of the occasion chaired the meeting. REPORT OF THE RAPPORTEUR- TECHNICAL SESSION-I

The TECHNICAL SESSION-I started at 10: 45 A.M. under the Chairmanship of Prof. G C Nanda, Prof. and Principal, University Department of Teacher Education, Bhubaneswar with Rapporteur Dr. Prabhabati Padhihari, Principal, Pattamundai Women's Degree College Pattamundai, Kendrapara. The first paper was presented by **Dr. Sanjay Ketan Swain**, Retd. Associate Professor, titled, "**Forward looking vision for India's higher education system – a historical perspectives**" in his paper he focused on Higher educational institutions as the centre for higher learning, are being confronted with new issues, challenges, threats and opportunities. He analysed the policy perspectives on higher education since Independence and provided empirical data and showcased that after independence there has been a phenomenal quantitative expansion of higher education institutions which is evident from the available data. He analysed the recommendations made by the Radhakrishnan Commission, the Kothari Commission, New Education Policy of 1968, National Policy on Education of 1986, Draft National Education Policy of 2019. He concluded that that the Framework of the draft policy is worth and can guide the educational development of the country for a long time to come. Many of the strategies out lined in the policy continue to be relevant and should be acted upon as it is more practical and action-oriented.

The second paper was presented by Dr. Sudarshan Mishra, Reader and HOD, Deptt. of Education, Ravenshaw University on the title "**Higher Education as Envisioned In National Education Policy: A Critical Reflection**" He started with Draft National Education Policy-2019 is really very exhaustive, covering all the dimensions of education with 436 pages excluding appendices. The major focus of the whole documents is to bring quality in education. However, certain anomalies are found in the document which needs to be revisited and whole talk was pointing out the major anomaly points as the present scenario of education in Odisha requires a lot of preparedness especially to comply with the ambitious Draft National Education Policy 2019. We need more centrally sponsored schemes for higher education.

Since our state constitutes with a substantial tribal population, which is found to be backward than other, needs more foresighted, strategic and constructive interventions.

Then the paper was presented by Dr.Kulamani Sahoo, Assistant Professor, University Department of Teacher Education, Utkal University, Vani Vihar, Bhubaneswar titled "**Activating Teachers for Quality Higher Education as Envisaged in Draft National Education Policy-2019**" He highlights on the challenges for faculty motivation in higher education institutions as envisioned in draft NEP-2019. The document emphasises on service condition for excellent teaching and research, faculty empowerment, merit based career management and creation of a culture of excellence through institutional leadership. Further he signifies the provision of adequate physical infrastructure and facilities, availability of faculty, institutional autonomy for faculty recruitment, permanent employment track system for staff for all college and universities. All the HEIs need to develop a plan for faculty, orientation programme for newly recruited faculty and mentoring of senior academicians including retired or outstanding faculty for improvement of quality of HEIs across disadvantaged districts. A 360 degree feedback system on assessment of contribution to teaching, research, practice, institutional developmental works is considered as yardstick for the faculty. All the academic staff would be of three levels such as: assistant professor, associate professor and professor across which promotions may happen depending on performance of individual faculty.

Dr. Tarulata Devi, Asso. Professor, Deptt. of Education, P.P.College, Nischintakoili, Cuttack,presented on "**ICT for Quality Distance Education**" she highlighted on the integration of ICT has heralded as a revolution for the teaching-learning system of Distance Education. With this backdrop, an attempt has been made in her paper to put forth the issues and concerns of ICT and its contributions towards realizing its implications for quality enhancement of Distance Education system.

Ms. Subhashree Pragyaprava Sarangi, Lecturer in Education, Birupa college, Indupur, Kendrapara presented on "**Role Of NPE-2019 for Successful Implementation in Higher Education**" in her thematic paper she analysed that

Higher education is probably one of the largest systems in the world. Higher education is higher dimension and quality aimed at an in-depth study of specific area of knowledge. Hence education is general where as higher education is particular. A specific area of education requires quality, research orientation innovation and regular updation and resource mobilization surveys conducted by government and private agencies so that students are not achieving the expected level of learning. In higher education the country does not have any representation in the top 200 universities of the world. In order to make changes in the field of education system, NPE plays a vital role. The focus of the NPE is on improving the quality of education and restoring the credibility of the education system.

Smt. Bidulata Sahoo, Research Scholar, Ravenshaw University, Cuttack presented on "**Learning Environment and Support for Students: As Envisaged in NEP-2020**" her paper describes how to create optimal learning environment how to provide student support to make higher education system quality based. She focuses on curriculum and pedagogy reformations in higher education guided by the National Higher Education Qualifications Framework, the Choice Based Credit System for flexibility and innovation, stimulating learning experiences through effective pedagogical practices; all students will also be offered meaningful opportunities for social engagement. Students will be assessed not only on academic aspects but also on broad capacities and dispositions, Academic, financial and emotional support for students to help them attain better outcomes was the main focus of her discussion.

After these presentations the Chair of this technical session Prof. G C Nanda, Prof. and Principal, University Department of Teacher Education, Bhubaneswar has given his technical remarks on each paper and showed satisfaction that the presenters had done their research work and corroborated their work with empirical research.

REPORT OF THE RAPPORTEUR- TECHNICAL SESSION-II

The **TECHNICAL SESSION-II** started at 02:30 P.M. under the Chairmanship of **Dr. Sanjaya Ketan Swain**, Associate Professor (Retd) S.V.M College, Jagatsinghpur and the rapporteur of the session was Dr. Tarulata Devi, Asso. Professor, Dept. of Education, P.P.College, Nischintakoili, Cuttack.

Ms. Chinmayee Dalai, Faculty of Education presented on "**Open and Distance Learning An Innovation To Enhance Higher Education**". In her talk she briefed about **how** education is now a day's survival tools in the world. Her paper presents a brief understanding of MOOCS (Massive Open Online Course). With its concept and objectives in Higher Education. It is a concrete knowledge about role of MOOCS (Massive Open Online Course) in higher education in a distance mode. It is a platform for providing different coeres in higher education through online mode, which is initiate by CUBE (Central Advisory Board of Education), MHRD (Ministry of Human Resource Development), and implement by UGC (University Grant Commission) and workable by SWAYAM (Study Webs of Active Learning for Young Aspiring Minds), NROER(National Responsibility of Open Educational Resources) etc that provide different type of innovative ideas for the development of students in higher education. Since the basic features of ODL (Open and Distance Learning) are converting the education system as superpower knowledge, it may fracases many challenges in term of funding, clarity in implementation and funding in higher education.

The second paper of the seminar was presented by Nibedita Nayak, Lecturer in Education, Pattamundai College, presented on "**Draft Educational Policy 2019: All You Need to Know**" She focused on aims and objectives of policy and briefed that the policy covers elementary education to colleges in both rural and urban India. The policy aims to universalize the pre-primary education by 2025 and provide foundational literacy / numeracy for all by 2025.

The next paper was presented by Mr. Subhashish Jena, Senior lecturer in Education, Evening College, Kendrapara focused on "Teachers Accountability:

National Education Policy 2020". He outlined the importance of teachers and the vital role of teachers in perspective of NPE 2020. He laid emphasis on teaching as a profession is different stream other professions because of its multigrade of dimensions. Teachers are the largest professional group engaged in human development activities. For the educational development the teachers need to be professionally equipped with various skills, competencies, commitment determination and accountability to give his best.

Dr. Prabhabati Padhihari, Senior Lecturer in Education, Pattamundai Women's College, Pattamundai presented on "**New Education Policy 2019: A Vision to Vocational Education**". She highlighted Vocational Education while giving focus to all spheres of education i.e., from Early Childhood Education, School Education, Higher education, Adult Education, Vocational Education, etc.,

The last paper of the session was presented by Neerupama Swain, Lecturer in Education, Pattamundai College, Pattamundai presented on "**Internationalisation of Indian Higher Education as Envisaged in Draft NEP-2019**". Her paper voiced **about** accelerated establishment of institutes which have originated over the last decade making India home to the largest number of Higher Education institutions in the world, with student enrolments at the second highest. Despite these numbers, international education rating agencies have not placed many of these institutions within the best of the world ranking. Also, India has failed to produce world class universities. Despite these challenges higher education system of India equally has lot of opportunities to overcome these challenges and have the capability to make its identity at international level. However, it needs greater transparency and accountability, the role of universities and colleges in the new millennium, and emerging scientific research on how people learn is of utmost important. India provides highly skilled people to other countries therefore; it is very easy for India to transfer our country from a developing nation to a developed nation.

After these presentations the Chair of this technical session of **Dr. Sanjaya Ketan Swain**, Associate Professor (Retd) S.V.M College, Jagatsinghpur has given his technical remarks on each paper and showed satisfaction that the presenters had done their research work and corroborated their work with empirical research and he appreciated the session for voicing the challenges and opportunities of higher education in different capacities.
