Technical session-II



REPORT OF THE RAPPORTEUR

Technical Session I

The first technical session was started at 11.00 a.m under the chairmanship of Dr Harischandra Sahoo, Director of Santakabi Bhima Bhoi Research Chair, Kalinga Institute of social science (KISS) Bhubaneswar, with the help of the rapporteur Mr Akshaya Kumar Sahoo, Reader in Philosophy, Birupa College, Indupur, Kendrapara. Mr Srimant Kumar Jena welcomed and introduced all the resource persons of this session. The chair person of this session requested Dr Arjun Charan Nayak, former Head of Department, Kendrapara Autonomous College, Kendrapara, to present his research paper and he also requested Mr Sahoo to brief down the talk of all the resource persons of the session of the conference.

Dr Nayak lighted on Aurobindo's philosophy the he seeks not only the individual liberty, not even of the entire human race, but of all the living beings suggests some Yogic process for the divinization of the body and then the divinization of society. Again he viewed that Aurobindo's intense spiritualizing gives rise to his ideal of human unity not only the material world, but the entire universe is the manifestation of the spirit. He also stated that Aurobindo conceives three layers of shelf; the first and the outer one constitute the physical self, the second constitutes vital self and the third is the mental self.

After Dr Nayak's presentation the chair person invited Dr Major Madan Mohan Das to present his paper. He spoke Brahaman in Advaita Vedanta Philosophy. He Said Brahaman is the key concept of Sankar's philosophy. The word 'Braham' literarily mean that which is great. Etymologically it is derived from the root 'Brh' which means to grow, to swells, to burst forth. So it may be viewed as the on manifested potentialities evolving itself into the world of names and forms. He also viewed that to Sankar, Brahaman, god

and individuals self are one and the same from paramarthika point of view. But from vyavaharika point of view we think them as different owing to avidya or ignorance or lack of proper knowledge.

Mr Narendra Prasad Behera, Lecturer in Logic and Philosophy, V N Autonomous College, Jajpur Road, came to deliver his talk accepting the invitation of the chair person after presentation of Dr Major Madan Mohan Das. He presented his paper on Sri Aurobindo's Philosophy of Consciousness. He said, according to Aurobindo, consciousness is a fundamental thing, the fundamental thing in existence. It is the energy, the motion, the movement of consciousness that creates the universe and all that is in it. He also said that Sri Aurobindo believed that the highest truths, the truths contain of science and religions were already contained in Vedas. The Gita and the Upanishads are nothing but a logical continuation of the Vedas. He believes in traditional concept of man accept the classical views about the union of individual soul with supreme soul.

Technical session II

The second technical session of the seminar was started at 2:30 p.m. under the chairmanship of Dr Major Madan Mohan Das, Former Associate Professor, Head of Department of Philosophy, Salipur Autonomous College, Salipur, with the help of Dr Arjun Charan Nayak as the Rapporteur of the session. Miss R N Madhusmita Parida introduced and welcomed resource persons of the second technical session of the one day State Level Seminar of department of philosophy, to the august seminar. The chair person requested Dr Nayak to briefly note the presentation of various scholars.

Dr Das invited Dr Sahoo to present his paper. Dr Sahoo spoke on the "Philosophy of Sri Aurobindo", he said that Aurobindo's metaphysics is grounded on Vedanta, and his interpretation on vedanta is unique, his originality consists in advocating that matter and spirit are not antithetical rather they form a continuum. It is a pure consciousness which expresses itself in the form of manifold particulars. The difference between matter and spirit is not of kind but of degree. For Sri Aurobindo, the ultimate reality is Sachidanada

that is Truth, Consciousness and Bliss. Again he added that the highest reality is one and only One. It is the concept of unity presupposing the concept of diversity.

After Dr Sahoo's presentation, Mr Debabrata Pradhan came. to present his paper accepting the invitation of chair person of the technical session II. Mr. Pradhan presented paper on "Relevance of Educational Philosophy of Sri Aurobindo in the Present Context". He said physical education includes control over physical functions, harmonious development of physical moments, overpowering limitations and the awareness of body consciousness. Sri Aurobindo lays stress upon games and sports because he felt that these were essential for renewing energy. He spoke that the edifice of Sri Aurobindo's philosophy is based upon his theory of evolution, it stand and falls with the truth of evolution. Sri Aurobindo aims at the evolution of the individual nation and humanity through education. This evolution should be continued as spiral. Evolution involves not only growth but also the transformation, not only adjustment but a more intimate harmony. This evolution can be achieved by man's opening and uniting with the universal divine. In other words, this requires divine perfection.

As an academician I thank all the resource persons, organizers and student of the college, media person of electronic and mass media as well as principal of this college. I express my heartfelt thanks once again to give me a chance to be in the dais to perform such an important work. Thank you all.

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
