Dear Chief Secretary/Administrator,

Please refer to Cabinet Secretary's D.O. letter No. 403/1/2/2015-GA.V dated 25<sup>th</sup> October, 2019 regarding the launch of a National Campaign for creating awareness about the 'Fundamental Duties' as part of the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the adoption of the Constitution of India. This national campaign will start from 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 and continue for one year.

2. This programme is to focus on Fundamental Duties and ensure that every citizen follows them systematically. The main strategy is to run it as a mass movement (rather than a government scheme) allowing participation of one and all.

3. It is essential that all academic institutions across all streams (colleges, professional colleges, law schools etc.) across all States and UTs are enlisted in the year-long awareness campaign.

4. The awareness campaign may include the following activities, which are suggested as under:-

(i) Administration of Pledge on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 alongwith reading of text of Fundamental Duties in all higher educational institutions in the States/UTs.

(ii) All the higher educational institutions may be asked to make arrangements for watching live the programme from the Central Hall of Parliament to commemorate the 70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Indian Constitution. It must be ensured that the programme is seen by as many students as possible, preferably in a central location.

(iii) Organising essays, debates, quiz and poster competitions focusing on fundamental duties and participate in large numbers in the National level competition that is being organized by UGC shortly.

(iv) Organising talks, workshop and symposia etc. by eminent citizens and legal luminaries.

- (v) Arranging screening of films/documentaries highlighting the framing of the Constitution or its various provisions and such other material as may be made available as part of the campaign.

- 5. Since the celebrations are going to be a spread over a year and involve multiple stakeholders, a State-level monitoring committee comprising of representatives from academic institutions and concerned officials may be constituted for proper coordination of the campaign.

# THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

1224

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a <sup>1</sup>[SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC] and to secure to all its citizens:

Preamble.

(1) JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity;

and to promote among them all

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the <sup>2</sup>[unity and integrity of the Nation];

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.




## REPORT

## PARAKRAM DIWAS

Subhash Chandra Bose, also known as Netaji, was one of the greatest sons and patriots of India. He was born in Calcutta on 23rd January 1897. His father, Jankinath Bose, was a well-known lawyer. The name of his mother was Srimati Prabhavati. His parents had a great influence on the boy Subhash. This pride and glory of India, called Subhash Chandra Bose, was a very intelligent and brilliant student. He came out a topper in his intermediate examination.

He passed his B.A in 1919 from Calcutta Presidency College. He went to England for higher studies and passed the I.C.S. Examination. I.C.S. was equivalent to the present IAS examination. But he did not accept any government position. He returned to India and joined the freedom movement. He was influenced by Gandhiji but deferred with him on the question of the method of attaining freedom. He believed that the use of force was necessary to throw out the British.

He was a great revolutionary. The Britishers were afraid of him and confined him to his own house. But he escaped from there and, disguised as a Pathan, reached Europe. There he formed the INA. Later he went to the Far East and joined Japan in his efforts to liberate India. He declared, **"Give me blood and I will give you freedom."** He gave the famous slogan **Jai Hind** was a great patriot and freedom fighter and he was very proud of being an Indian.

Bose was the ninth child of a family of 14 and the sixth son of Janakinath Bose, a lawyer of the Kayasth caste. He entered an English School in Cuttack at the age of five and in 1909, was transferred to Ravenshaw Collegiate School. He matriculated from Cuttack in 1913 and joined the Presidency College in Calcutta. His early influences included his headmaster, Beni Madhav Das, and the teachings of Swami Vivekananda and Ramakrishna Paramahansa. The latter brought about a spiritual awakening in the 15-year-old Bose.

At 17, Bose suddenly left his college in Calcutta without a word to his parents and went on a pilgrimage in search of a spiritual guru. After visiting renowned gurus of his day in places such as Rishikesh, Hardwar, Mathura, Brindavan, Varanasi and Gaya, he failed to find a guru whom he could follow and returned to Calcutta utterly disappointed.<sup>5</sup> By 1916, the rebellious Bose was expelled from Presidency College and banished from Calcutta University over an incident where students attacked English professor, E. F. Oaten. However, he was accepted in Scottish Church College, Calcutta in 1917, graduating with first class honours in philosophy in 1919.<sup>6</sup> He entered Cambridge University on 9 September 1919 to study for the Indian Civil Service Examination, placing fourth after only eight months of study.<sup>7</sup> Even so, Bose did not stay long in the civil service, resigning in July 1921 and returning home.<sup>8</sup>

### **Politics**

In India, Bose met with the Indian leaders, Mahatma Gandhi and Chittaranjan Das, and joined the Congress Party. Soon after, Bose and Das were arrested on Christmas day in 1921 for successfully organising a boycott against the Prince of Wales's visit to India, and were sentenced to six months' imprisonment. Upon his release, Bose busied himself with flood relief work, editorial services for the publication *Forward* in Calcutta and conducting propaganda for the Swaraj Party.

In 1924, Bose was appointed Chief Executive Officer of the Calcutta Corporation at the same time when Das was elected Mayor of Calcutta. Bose was again detained in Mandalay, under the new Bengal Ordinance on 24 October 1924. He was released only two-and-a-half years later on the grounds of ill health, as he was suffering from tuberculosis. From 1928 to 1937, he remained in politics, and was arrested twice by British authorities. He was

appointed President of the Indian Congress Party in 1938 but resigned on 28 April 1939. Bose was an advocate of armed resistance against British colonialism; he could not come to terms with the ideology of non-violent resistance that Gandhi advocated. Upon his resignation, he formed the All India Forward Bloc on 3 May 1939, a party within Congress, in an attempt to bring together the leftist faction and to fight Gandhism. He fought a losing battle against both Gandhi and the Congress party for 20 months until he was removed from the presidency of the Bengal Provincial Congress Committee and banned from holding any elective office for three years. In March 1940, Bose convened an Anti-Compromise Conference at Ramgarh in Bihar under the joint auspices of the Forward Bloc and Kisan Sabha, and by June of that year, was demanding the establishment of a Provisional National Government in India.

Arrested again on 21 July 1940, Bose this time went on a hunger strike, demanding his release, which came only in December 1940. Despite strict surveillance, Bose managed to escape under the guise of an up-country Muslim gentleman. With the help of the Italian embassy, and travelling under the name of Orlando Mazzota, he reached Germany via Moscow. There he recruited Indian prisoners-of-war in Europe and north Africa to form the Indian Legion (Azad Hind Fauj or Free India Army) to fight for India's freedom. Inspired by his leadership, his followers in Berlin honoured him with the name Bose Netaji, acknowledging his stature as a leader.

### **Malaya**

Bose arrived in Singapore on 2 July 1943 at the invitation of revolutionary freedom fighter Rash Bihari Bose. He was appointed President of the Indian Independence League and took over from Rash Bihari Bose as leader of the Indian Independence League in East Asia. On 21 October 1943, Subhas Chandra Bose proclaimed the formation of the Provisional Government of Free

India at Cathay Cinema Hall. Two days later, he declared war on Britain and the United States.<sup>15</sup> With help from the Japanese, he re-organised and rejuvenated the Azad Hind Fauj (also called the Indian National Army). He lobbied aggressively for funds in Malaya and other parts of Southeast Asia and launched a recruitment drive for the Azad Hind Fauj.

Tapping into the widespread discontent of Indian army personnel in Malaya, especially over the way British officers had abandoned them during their retreat from Singapore, Bose was able to recruit many British Indian troops to the Azad Hind Fauj. On 14 April 1944, he led the Azad Hind Fauj on an offensive against the British in India. Crossing the Burmese border, he planted the Indian National tri-colour flag at Moirang, Manipur. It was a symbol of claiming Indian soil from the British. However, the offensive failed to take Kohima and Imphal and the troops retreated to Burma. The campaign was considered a failure and Bose left for Singapore via Bangkok on 24 April 1944.

### **Contribution of Netaji to Get Freedom of India**

He was extremely dissatisfied with the dejected conditions of the other countrymen for the reason of their awful and brutal behaviour by the Britishers. He was determined to join the nationalist association in the place of the civil service to help the natives of India through its freedom. He was influenced a lot with the loyalist Deshbandhu Chittaranjan Das and was later on chosen as the Mayor of Kolkata and then the President of Indian National Congress. Soon after that he left the party because of the estimation differences with Mahatma Gandhi in 1939. After parting from the congress party, he founded his own Forward Bloc party.

### **Establishment of Azad Hind Fauj**

He supposed that non-violence movement is not adequate to arrive at freedom from the British rule so he chose the opposite; the violence movement to fetch freedom in the nation. He went away to Germany and then to Japan where he made his very own Indian National armed forces, also known as the Azad Hind Fauj. He had incorporated some Indian prisoners of war as well as some Indian inhabitants of those countries in his Azad Hind Fauj to battle courageously against the British rule. He gave catchphrase or a slogan to his army named '**Delhi Chalo**' and '**Jai Hind**'. He had motivated his army men through his splendid words of "**Give me blood and I will give you freedom**" to make the land of his birth free from the law of the Britishers.






