
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 462 response




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 462 responses




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? 462 responses




4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 462 responses




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 462 responses


















