In natural farming chemical or organic fertilizers are not added into the soil in fact, decomposition of organic matter by microbes and earthworms is encouraged right on the soil surface itself, which gradually adds nutrition in the soil, over the period.

It is a diversified farming system that integrates crops, trees and livestock, allowing the optimum use of functional biodiversity. Natural farming if done effectively enhances farmers' income while delivering many other benefits, such as restoration of soil fertility and environmental health, reducing greenhouse gas emissions. Natural Farming builds on natural or ecological processes that exist in or around farms.

This farming approach was **introduced by Masanobu Fukuoka, a Japanese farmer and philosopher**, in his 1975 book *The One-Straw Revolution*.

Shri Subhash Palekar introduced natural farming in India. He is an agricultural scientist who pioneered the concept of Natural Farming in the country. Palekar drew his inspiration from ancient Indian farming techniques, at the heart of which are cow dung and cow urine.

There are several states practicing Natural Farming. Prominent among them are Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Kerala, Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Jharkhand, Odisha, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Tamil Nadu.

Internationally, Natural Farming is considered a form of regenerative agriculture—a prominent strategy to save the planet.

In India, Natural farming is promoted as **Bhartiya Prakritik Krishi Paddhati Programme (BPKP)** under **Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY)**.

BPKP is aimed at promoting traditional indigenous practices which reduce externally purchased inputs.

Features of Natural Farming

According to natural farming principles, plants get 98% of their supply of nutrients from the air, water, and sunlight. And the remaining 2% can be fulfilled by good quality soil with plenty of friendly microorganisms. (Just like in forests and natural systems)

The soil is always supposed to be covered with organic mulch, which creates humus and encourages the growth of friendly microorganisms.

Farm made bio-cultures named 'Jeevamrit, Beejamrit etc.' are added to the soil instead of any fertilizers to improve microflora of soil. Jeevamrit, Beejamrit are derived from very little cow dung and cow urine of desi cow breed.

It holds the promise of enhancing farmers' income while delivering many other benefits, such as restoration of soil fertility and environmental health, and mitigating and/or reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

The system requires cow dung and cow urine (Gomutra) obtained from Indian breed cow only. Desi cow is apparently the purest as far as the microbial content of cow dung, and urine goes.

In natural farming, neither chemical nor organic fertilizers are added to the soil. In fact, no external fertilizers are added to soil or given to plants whatsoever.

In natural farming, decomposition of organic matter by microbes and earthworms is encouraged right on the soil surface itself, which gradually adds nutrition in the soil, over the period.

In natural farming there is no ploughing, no tilling of soil and no fertilizers, and no weeding is done just the way it would be in natural ecosystems.

Natural, farm-made pesticides like Dashparni ark and Neem Astra are used to control pests and diseases.

Weeds are considered essential and used as living or dead mulch layer.

Multi-cropping is encouraged over single crop method.

Natural Farming aims to make farming viable and aspirational by increasing net incomes of farmers on account of cost reduction, reduced risks, similar yields, incomes from intercropping. Natural farming generates employment on account of natural farming input enterprises, value addition, marketing in local areas, etc.

The four pillars of ZBNF are:

Jivamrita/jeevamrutha.

Bijamrita/beejamrutha.

Acchadana – mulching.

Whapasa – moisture.

A Brief Report on Intellectual Property Rights

These are the rights given to persons over the creations of their minds. They usually give the creator an exclusive right over the use of his/her creation for a certain period of time.

Intellectual property rights are customarily divided into two main areas:

The rights of authors of literary and artistic works (such as books and other writings, musical compositions, paintings, sculpture, computer programs and films) are protected by copyright, for a minimum period of 50 years after the death of the author. Also protected through copyright and related (sometimes referred to as "neighbouring") rights are the rights of performers (e.g. actors, singers and musicians), producers of phonograms (sound recordings) and broadcasting organizations.

The main social purpose of protection of copyright and related rights is to encourage and reward creative work. Industrial property can usefully be divided into two main areas: One area can be characterized as the protection of distinctive signs, in particular trademarks (which distinguish the goods or services of one undertaking from those of other undertakings) and geographical indications (which identify a good as originating in a place where a given characteristic of the good is essentially attributable to its geographical origin). The protection of such distinctive signs aims to stimulate and ensure fair competition and to protect consumers, by enabling them to make informed choices between various goods and

services. The protection may last indefinitely, provided the sign in question continues to be distinctive. Other types of industrial property are protected primarily to stimulate innovation, design and the creation of technology. In this category fall inventions (protected by patents), industrial designs and trade secrets. The social purpose is to provide protection for the results of investment in the development of new technology, thus giving the incentive and means to finance research and development activities. A functioning intellectual property regime should also facilitate the transfer of technology in the form of foreign direct investment, joint ventures and licensing. The protection is usually given for a finite term (typically 20 years in the case of patents).
