COLLEGE AT A GLANCE:

Pattamundai College, Pattamundai is a premier educational institution acknowledged in the state of Odisha permanently affiliated to Utkal University for its variety of impetus. It has invited attention of state level educational fraternity towards its recognition as the biggest educational institution in state both in quality and quantity parameters. The education alone can correct the social ills such as caste hierarchy, money-lending, illiteracy, untouchability, superstitions and social and economic inequality. Establishment of Pattamundai College bears the value for its contribution to substantiate above issues through its education in general. From the very beginning it has enormously tried to its level best to give emphasis on the education of the down-trodden, the poor and the ignorant that really form the major bulk of the society. It was established on 5th July 1970 as an Arts College situated in Pattamundai block of Kendrapara district in the State of Odisha which is now fully grown to a leading institution. The college has full of attractive greenery campus of many varieties of timber yielding and medicinal plants with ornamental and fruit gardens spreading over an area of 14.6 acres of land, in the vicinity of Pattamundai town. It provides quality education in Arts, Science and commerce streams 14 UG programmes. The college has a permanent affiliation and has been listed under 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC act in 1977 which withstands the academic and administrative standards of the college. In response to the changing needs of the society and as per UGC norms innovative experiments are being carried out with help of computer networking for making the teaching learning process interactive and participative. With the need of the time, the institution expanded its area of innovation in different respects to meet the requirement of the students as well as different stake holders. With the infrastructural growth such as addition of new buildings, hostels, renovation of library laboratories and playground, it also emphasized to enhance its academic quality to reach the institution to a new height.

Curricular Aspects:

- To introduce add on/certificate courses on PG DCA, Tailoring, Beauty Parlour courses, Plumbing, Welding for the students.
- To increase student intake capacity of existing courses and improve student enrolment.
- To promote the faculty members to participate/organize the refresher course, FDP, Orientation course at University level.
- To conduct academic, green, gender and other quality related audits.
- Augmentation of academic infrastructure.
- To establish the well structured feedback system on curriculum from all the stake holders.
- To enrich ICT enabled infrastructure in the institution.
- Automation of central library and addition of e-resources like INFLIBNET, SWAYAM, MOOCs, e-Books to Library
- Augmentation of departmental library facilities.
- To promote the faculty to use ICT based teaching methodology.
- To conduct different programmes for the slow learners as well as for the advanced learners

- To make improvement in infrastructure facilities like construction of more class rooms and laboratories, instrumentation facility, construction of indoor sports facility and gymnasium, hostel facility on the campus.
